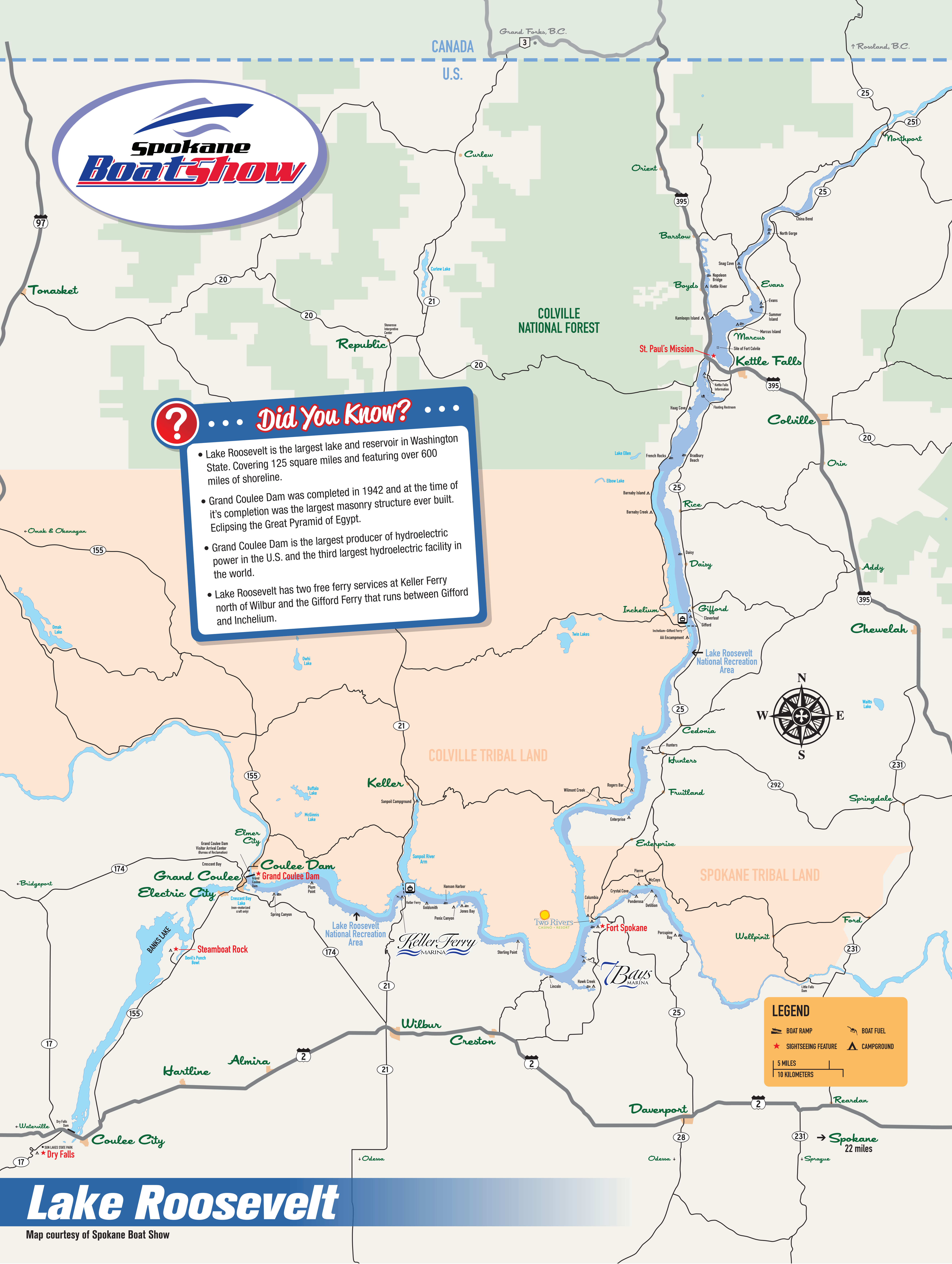




### Did You Know?

- Lake Roosevelt is the largest lake and reservoir in Washington State. Covering 125 square miles and featuring over 600 miles of shoreline.
- Grand Coulee Dam was completed in 1942 and at the time of it's completion was the largest masonry structure ever built. Eclipsing the Great Pyramid of Egypt.
- Grand Coulee Dam is the largest producer of hydroelectric power in the U.S. and the third largest hydroelectric facility in the world.
- Lake Roosevelt has two free ferry services at Keller Ferry north of Wilbur and the Gifford Ferry that runs between Gifford and Inchelium.
