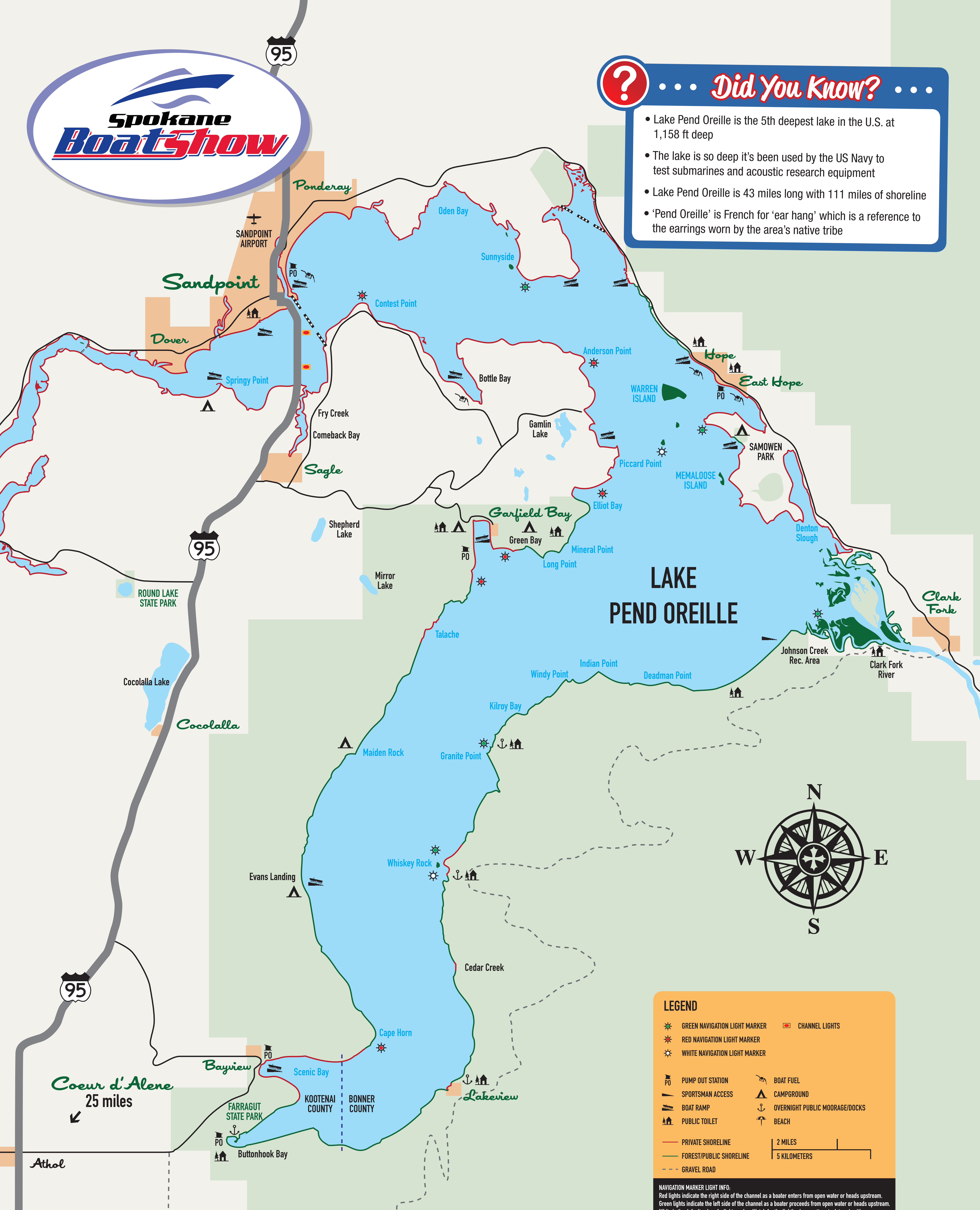




Did You Know?

- Lake Pend Oreille is the 5th deepest lake in the U.S. at 1,158 ft deep
- The lake is so deep it's been used by the US Navy to test submarines and acoustic research equipment
- Lake Pend Oreille is 43 miles long with 111 miles of shoreline
- 'Pend Oreille' is French for 'ear hang' which is a reference to the earrings worn by the area's native tribe

NAVIGATION MARKER LIGHT INFO:
 Red lights indicate the right side of the channel as a boater enters from open water or heads upstream.
 Green lights indicate the left side of the channel as a boater proceeds from open water or heads upstream.
 White is the default color of a light marker. Watch for the light's phase pattern to determine its purpose.
